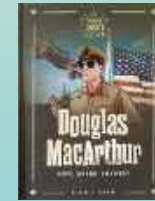
Amos Fortune, Free Man

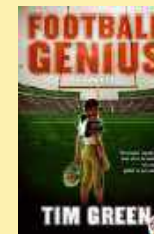
