Sources of CHILD Income	
Source	Example
Gross Earnings From Work	A child has a regular full or part time job where they earn a salary or wages
Social Security (Disability payments, Survivor's Benefits)	A child is blind or disabled and receives Social Security benefits. A parent is disabled, retired, or deceased and their child received social security benefits.
Income from persons outside the household	A friend or extended family member regularly gives a child spending money.
Income from any other source	A child receives regular income from a private pension fund, annuity, or trust.

Source	Example
Earnings from Work	Gross salary, wages, cash bonuses Net income from self-employment (farm or business). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Farm - line 18 of Schedule 1 or Line 34 from Schedule F • Business - Line 12 of Schedule 1 or Line 31 from Schedule C If you are in the U.S. Military: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic pay and cash bonuses (do not include combat pay, FSSA, or privatized housing allowances) • Allowances for off-base housing, food, or clothing.
Public Assistance Alimony Child Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unemployment benefits • Worker's Compensation • Supplemental Security Income (SSI) • Cash assistance from State or local government • Alimony payments • Child support payments • Veteran's benefits • Strike Benefits
Pension Retirement All Other Income	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social security (including railroad retirement and black lung benefits) • Private pensions or disability benefits • Regular income from trusts or estates • Annuities • Investment income • Earned interest • Rental income • Regular cash payments from outside the household.
