If you would have interest in having your son attend this high school, please consider attending this presentation.

First Communion for our third graders is on Sunday, November 14th, at noon.

I had put the following in the back-to-school letter that was in the August packet and it still is where we are at for virtual learning: *...Students that are isolated or quarantined can learn virtually, but students absent for a short period of time such as a day or two will not, unless the individual teacher contacts the student.*

We are heading towards the end of quarter one and have a few items of note. Next Friday, the 29th, is a Diocesan in-service, thus there is no school at St. Mary's, but the public school will have school that day. Friday, November 5th, is the end of quarter one. Report cards will be sent home the following week.

Mandatory P-S-T conferences will be Thursday, November 18th, from 3 – 9. Sign up for conferences will begin today for all families that have 3 or more children at St. Mary's so that those parents can book conference times that are close to each other. On Wednesday, sign up will be open for all parents. You do not need to sign up for each teacher listed, just your HR teacher, however, you can optionally sign up for additional teachers if needed. If you need assistance in signing up for conferences, please contact the school. Thank you.

The following is a review on how to sign up via Sycamore:

1. Log into Sycamore.
2. Click on My School on the left side.
3. Under My School, select my P/T Conferences.
4. Select your student from the drop down and then click on any available green box for the teacher(s) you would like to see. (See below). You will be able to sign up for conferences for each of your students. Once you confirm the time, you will need to contact St. Mary's if you need to change it.
