Dear Parents,

The end of quarter 3 is this Friday, the 26th. Report cards will be sent home on Tuesday, the 30th.

The 26th will also be the last day for the Mite Box collections, which can be handed in to your child(ren)'s homeroom teacher.

The public school decided to go back to in-person instruction five days a week starting the week of April 6th. One effect on us will be busing. Starting next Monday, March 29th, there will be one route only so there will no longer be a 2:20 pick up for the rest of the year starting March 29th. For St. Mary's students, the pick-up time and bus numbers for every day, including on Wednesday, the 7th, and Wednesdays beyond, will be the same as what they currently are on MTRF. The only exceptions would be April 16 and May 21 as we have school, while the public school will not, thus those 2 days we will use our current Wednesday, St. Mary's only, one route bus schedule (so don't throw that Wednesday bus schedule out quite yet).

We now have \$10's and \$25's of Kamenick Farms and Catering, LLC gift certificates for SCRIP. (They can only be used at the store in town, not at the farm or berry patch.). Purchase of the certificates gives 10% back to the school.

This Thursday we will have a menu change. 5K and 1 will have pizza, grades 2 – 4, chicken patty/bun and grades 5 – 8, there is no change, it is still hamburger/bun.

Students will have Stations of the Cross before Easter break. Depending on the grade, students will have it in person or a recorded version.
