## Parent Survey Analysis

The parent survey completed online illustrates that of the 37 statements, 16 have 100% that agree and 14 more have over 90% agree. The other seven questions had a majority agree, but less than 90% agreed.

The parent survey illustrates that the respondents believe St. Mary's has high academic standards, is a faith filled school which is modeled by school staff, has opportunities for parents to participate in their child's faith formation, provides information on programs to help their children and has sufficient extracurricular opportunities. Over 90% of parents indicate they know the mission of the school, the facilities are conducive to learning and they would recommend St. Mary's to other families.

Areas that were lower included that St. Mary's needs to provide opportunities for parent faith formation. Currently, parents are invited to attend Mass, the Rosary, Stations of the Cross, Sacrament retreats, share how they express their faith for Advent and Lent, as well as being invited to groups such as That Man in You and some of the Diocesan retreats offered. There are more opportunities that are possible for parents that can be shared such as additional Diocesan retreats and St. Anthony retreats as well. Another area is using technology effectively. The question is general, so it's important to find out what areas of technology are not being used effectively. A student survey with some of those specifics was previously conducted and based off of this parent survey, an additional student survey was completed 10/20/22. The survey indicated some students had trouble logging in at times, but they thought overall technology was effectively used at St. Mary's. A third area was that teachers use different approaches to instruction. This was mentioned in the staff survey as some staff desired professional development in different forms of instruction and techniques for the whole child. Some of these techniques are part of the in-services when we get new textbooks, but additional in-services will be scheduled to help in this area. Finally, knowing the school's financial status. Some financial information was given in the August back to school packet that showed revenue and expenses but more can be shared and through different mediums. The school is in a good financial situation, and has improved its situation over the past 5 years. Also, there are misconceptions on how the school is funded and how money is spent, possibly due to the lack of sharing this financial information, so sharing more information would be helpful.
