

Parishioner Survey

The majority of people who responded to the parish survey agreed with all the statements on the survey. One respondent disagreed with the majority of statements. Taking out that singular response, 23 of the 28 questions had 100% of respondents agree. The five statements that had some disagreement were: our school instills in students a responsibility to evangelize, our school has a process to address the concerns of students and parents, information about the school is regularly made available to the parish/school community, I am aware of the school's financial situation and the physical condition of our school is conducive to effective teaching and learning. Comments included a facility update with changes in lighting, climate control, refresh paint/carpet/tile and that the students are not instructed to bless themselves with their right hand or genuflect with their right knee and that the teachers don't do it correctly either.

There is a facilities plan for future changes that includes lighting and flooring but not climate control. This relates to the question of the school being conducive to learning as well. The use of the right knee and hand at church is taught but can be emphasized as well as the question related to evangelize. The financial situation of the school can also be shared through a variety of ways. The other two questions are related to communication and are part of our communication plan that can be reviewed.
