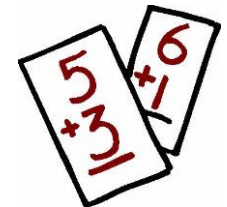
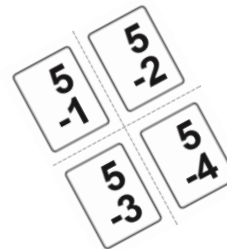

- **ABSOLUTELY NO MECHANICAL PENCILS**
