SIS and Technology Information



Hello parents,


Our Student Information System (SIS) is called Sycamore. Staff will take attendance and lunch orders online and in grades 5 - 8 will be keeping grades online. Thus staff, students and parents in those grades will be able to see more information than in other grades. Sycamore is also used to help schedule events like PST conferences. Instructions for conference sign up time in Sycamore:

- 1. Log into Sycamore
- On the right side you should see "My Students" and a picture of your child(ren). Below the pic you should see a blue link "Check Your Schedule". Click on the link and proceed to #4. If you do not see that, go to #2.
- 2. Click on My School on the left side.
- 3. Under My School, select my P/T Conferences
- 4. Select your child(ren) from the drop down and then click on any available green box. Once you confirm the time, you will need to contact St. Mary's if you need to change it.

There are different views based on whether you are a parent, staff, student or administrator. As a parent, you can modify your demographic information and opt into parental notifications to see when your child is marked tardy or falls below a certain percentage in a class (grades 5 through 8). Other items are read only and include seeing your student's attendance, discipline records, schedule and grades (again largely for grades 5 through 8). Also attached is some information that will help you navigate through the SIS. It will tell you how to log in, access information, opt into notifications (optional) and verify and update information. After which, there is information about Chromebooks and G Suite we purchased and then the sign off sheet.

Logging into Sycamore School

You have been provided with your login information. A school ID (3871), user name and password are required to access the Sycamore School community. The website address is: app.sycamoreschool.com/index.php?schoolid=3871. There is a link on our homepage as well (top right corner) www.stmarysmarathon.org.



If you are a new user, there are two things you should do right away so that you can full navigation in your Sycamore school site:

- 1. Follow the Welcome Aboard directions to set up your browser. You will need to do this for each computer and browser you use. This process lets your browser know that app.sycamoreeducation.com and app.sycamoreschool.com are trusted sites for you.
- 2. Change your password to one that is secure. Once you change it, it will also be encrypted, making it more secure.

Changing Your Password

If your password was newly activated or was reset by the school, you will be required to change your password upon logging in. You will not be able to access any other areas within Sycamore until this step is completed. You will receive an email confirming you made the change.

When your school activated your account, a password was automatically generated for you. We suggest that you change your password to something that only you know and that is easy for you to remember. To do this, go to My Organizer (left menu), and click on password.

The Super User at your school cannot look up your password for you in case you forget it (for security reasons), but they can change it for you.

If you use the Reset Your password link and respond to the email that you verify the request is from you, there will be a new computer generated password that you will receive with the second email. In order to change this, you will need to log in with the temporary password then go to

My Organizer Password to change it. The temporary password is the one you will enter in the "Old password" field.


The homepage is where you land when you first login to Sycamore (IF you have okay'd the Welcome Aboard message and changed your password). Any time you want to get back to this page, you need to click on the Home link in the upper left menu.

NOTE - you have to first set up your computer (1. Say ok to the Welcome Aboard Message and 2. Change your password) before you will see the full Homepage.

The home page contains the following fields:

- 1. The **header** across the top displays your school name, logo and the current school year. Clicking on the logo will link to the school's public web site. In the top right, you will also see icons with your students' names listed below or thumbnail photos for each of your current students. Clicking on an icon will open that student's profile.
- 2. **Information My Students** will show your students' names in blue and if you click on their name you will see a menu and be able to click to see Documents, Schedules, Grades, Attendance and or Homework/Assignments.

- 1. To the **left** is the Sycamore Education school site menu items.
- 2. The **center** section of the home page will list recent news articles, upcoming calendar events, uploaded documents or photos depending on which tab is on the top.
- 3. The last area on the homepage is a vertical display of boxes on the **right** of the page that offer information that pertains to the school, which may include: Link to school related webpages, Flash News, Today's Events, Staff Logged In, Documents, and Photos or Link Highlights. Also in this area is a display of your Local Weather based on your school's zip code.

Accessing Class Pages

You can access your student's classroom web pages in two clicks. Hover over your student's photo or icon at top right to see a menu, then click on the Schedule item:



You will then see your student's schedule; click on the name of a specific class to go into that class site:





The Classroom Menu

The following is an overview of current menu options a parent will have available to them as listed in order on the menu.

- **School**: The items on the menu under Classroom are News, Calendar, Documents and Photos. Tabs across the top function in the same way as at the school level but are specific to this particular class.
- Front Desk: Click on Staff to get a listing of any teachers associated with the class. Click on the Pass-a-Note icon to pass them a note if this has been enabled for your school. The Photos tab at the top will display the teacher's picture if the school office has uploaded it. Ignore information in the Information Center and Break Room. System Help can give you information on how to use the system.


Dynamic windows (displayed on the right side of the page)

Similar to the school home page, the windows on the right side of the classroom web page are dynamic and may change from time to time.


- **Flash News**: Any news needing the attention of parents or deemed urgent may appear as a scrolling news article in the upper right corner.
- **Teachers**: Any teachers or assistants associated with the class are listed here. You can Pass-a-Note to the individual by clicking on the Pass-a-Note icon to the right of their name.
- **Students**: This lists the names of students in the class. This window can be collapsed by clicking on the minus sign in the box in the heading of the window.
- Current Assignments: Any current assignments the teacher has assigned for this class are displayed with the due date. Click on the title in blue text for details of the assignment. Assignment due dates will also appear on the classroom calendar.
- **Photo Highlights**: Any photo the teacher has chosen to highlight will be displayed. Multiple highlighted photos cycle through at random.
- **Documents Highlights**: Any classroom document that your teacher would like you to have easy access to may be highlighted on the home page. It could be a field trip permission slip or school supply list, etc.
- Links: Common website links for this classroom may be highlighted for your reference. For example, a science class might choose to highlight www.discoverychannel.com

Parent Notifications

Primary family contacts can opt-in to email notifications. The notification types are attendance and grades (please note grades 5 through 8) and will be sent once per day. Each notification will include relevant activity from the last 24 hours. These notifications will be sent out at a specific time designated by the school. Access this in your **My Family** | **Contacts**| by clicking on the Primary Contact name.



On the contact profile, go to the Notifications tab and select the notifications you would like. Posted Grade refers to the posted average grade for a class, not an individual assignment grade.




Daily email notifications NOT Activated

Updating Information

Under My Family/Information, you can update such things as your address. Under My Family/Contacts, you can update emergency contact and authorized pick up information.

Under My Family/Medical you can update medical information. In the comments section, please put any information about allergies or medical alerts. If you update the medical page please contact the school.

In all 3 cases make sure to click the blue update button in the top right corner.



In addition to Sycamore, we have Chromebooks and GSuite for student use. The students can use the Chromebooks at school only but have access to GSuite and Google Docs in and out of school. Their username is generally 1^{st} letter of first name and whole last name@stmarysmarathon.org. If there is a person with the same last name and 1^{st} letter their username will be slightly different. The students will be resetting their password so you can help them choose a good one; it needs to be 8 characters. Please tell them not to share their new password. Students in grades 5-8 will be using these devices the most for such activities as Internet searches, lab reports, AR tests and papers while students in younger grades will have less exposure. Students can share docs only with their teachers and do not have access to e-mail through these accounts.

Google Apps

These apps are used more in older grades with students in grades 5-8 having knowledge of Google Docs and Google Drive before the closure in the classes they were taking. After the closure, this had become a major way of submitting docs/assignments. During the closure, Google Meet was being used for video conferencing by some teachers to help teach lessons. Google Classroom was widely being used for teachers in Grades 7/8. More detailed information on each app is contained below.

G Sutto Co	This may be referred to as "the waffle". It is found towards the top right of the screen when using any of the Google Apps or when chrome is first opened. When it is clicked, all the other available Google Apps appear.
Docs Slides Sheets A Share	Google Docs, Google Slides, and Google Sheets which are Google equivalents to Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, and Excel. Also, to share these with teachers, just click the blue share button found in the top right corner and type in the teacher's school email address.
Drive	Google Drive is used to store any files for a Google account. This can also be used to create new Google Docs, Sheets, or Slides for assignments.
Meet	Google Meet is used for video conferences. Teachers will provide joining information, which includes a url to use on a device (chromebook, laptop, tablet, phone, etc.) and a phone number and pin to use for a call-in if you do not have wifi. Once the url is typed in, just click join now.

Chat	Google Chat is a messaging platform. This is an easy way for students to contact teachers with questions or for them to set up a time for a Google Meet.
31 Calendar	Google Calendar is the place where assignment due dates will be if a teacher uses Google Classroom. Also, scheduled Google Meets will be on their calendar if a teacher invited them. To join the meeting at the scheduled time, just click the meeting on the calendar and press join Hangouts Meet.

To join a class, just click the + found towards the top right corner and enter the code the teacher supplied. Once you're in a classroom, there are four main tabs in the middle of the top of the screen. The first is Stream, which is like the homepage that has updates, such as joining information for Google Meets, and a list of upcoming assignments. Then, there is Classwork, which is where assignments' directions and other material can be found. This is also where students submit assignments for teachers to grade. Next, there is People just to give a list of students in the class. Finally, if a teacher chooses to enter grades in Google Classroom, it will be in Grades, which in addition to stating the grade for each assignment, it also tells whether an assignment is missing or was late. The 3 lines in front of the class name is how students can switch to view a different Google Classroom.
